SE5000 Digital Tachograph: One Million Units Produced

Back in 2006, the very first SE5000 digital tachograph rolled off the production line, into a world that was very different to today. Back in 2006, we were still living in a pre-iPhone world and Facebook had just opened to public.

Now, in 2017, Stoneridge Electronics are proud to announce that they have manufactured 1 million SE5000 digital tachographs. The one-millionth unit was produced in August at their production facility in Örebro, Sweden, and will be fitted into a new DAF truck.

Since the first unit, the Stoneridge SE5000 has been updated for the “one minute rule”, integrated “Driver Decision Support” to help drivers optimise their time on the road as well as adding Working Time Directive calculations. And nowadays, drivers are used to working with mobile Apps and remote download, and Stoneridge have been there to support them every step of the way.

Marianne Frogner, Vice President of Tachograph Systems, commented; “we are delighted to celebrate production of our millionth digital tachograph. As we prepare to build our next million units, things will change again when the 1C legislation comes into force in 2019 but Stoneridge will continue to be there for the millions of drivers and fleets throughout Europe and provide innovative products and services for the industry”.
